I really enjoy travelling to find out more about the world. My favourite places I have been so far include Sorrento and Capri.

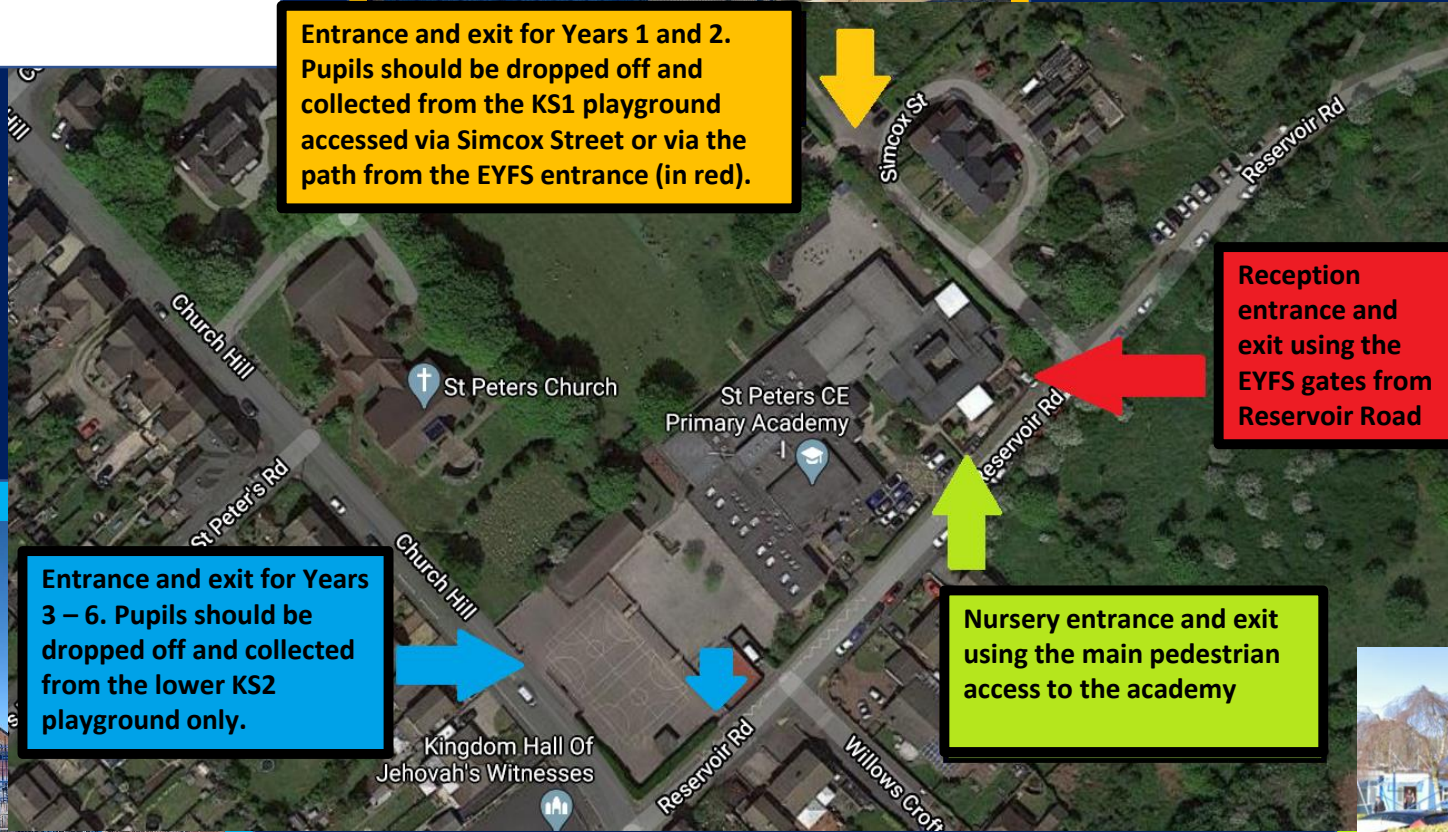

Entrance and Exits for Year Groups: September 2023



Entrance and exit for Years 1 and 2. Pupils should be dropped off and collected from the KS1 playground accessed via Simcox Street or via the path from the EYFS entrance (in red).



Reception entrance and exit using the EYFS gates from Reservoir Road

Nursery entrance and exit using the main pedestrian access to the academy

Entrance and exit for Years 3 – 6. Pupils should be dropped off and collected from the lower KS2 playground only.



Entrances Years 1 and 2

Year 2 enter the building here, down the steps and directly into their classrooms

Year 1 enter the building here and straight into their cloakroom



Exits Years 1 and 2

Year 1H will be dismissed from the castle gate at 3.10pm

Year 2 will be dismissed from these steps by staff at 3.10pm

Year 1P will be dismissed from this door at 3.10pm



Entrances Years 3 to 6

Years 3 to 6 should wait on the lower KS2 playground and then access their classrooms directly from the playground using both sets of steps. All children have been shown their access point and staff will be on hand to help at the start of term



Exits Years 3 to 6

Year 3 will be dismissed from these steps at 3.20pm

Year 5 will be dismissed from these steps at 3.25pm

Year 4 will be dismissed from these steps at 3.20pm

Year 6 will be dismissed from these steps at 3.25pm



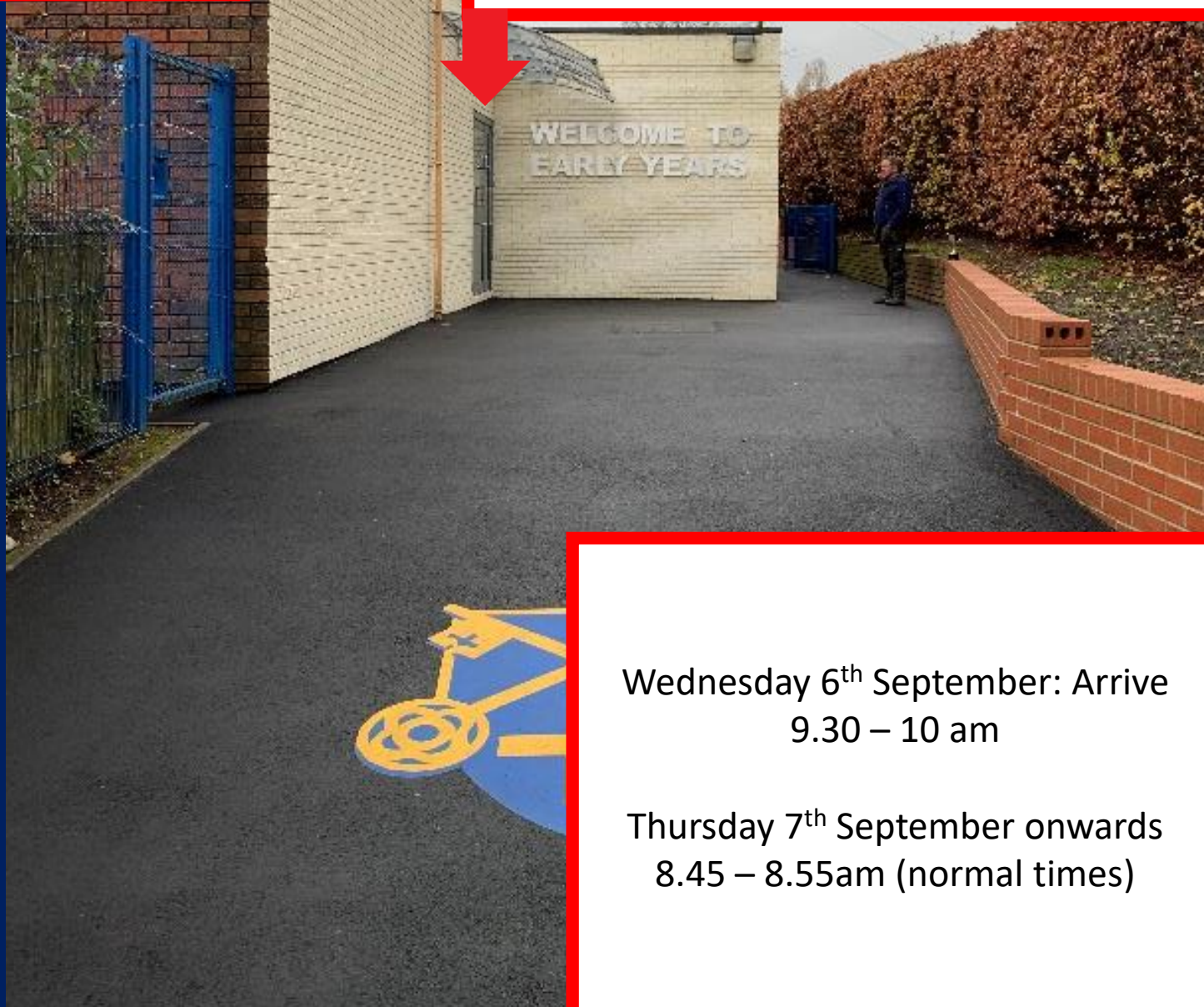
Entrance and Exit Nursery

Reception Early Years entrance

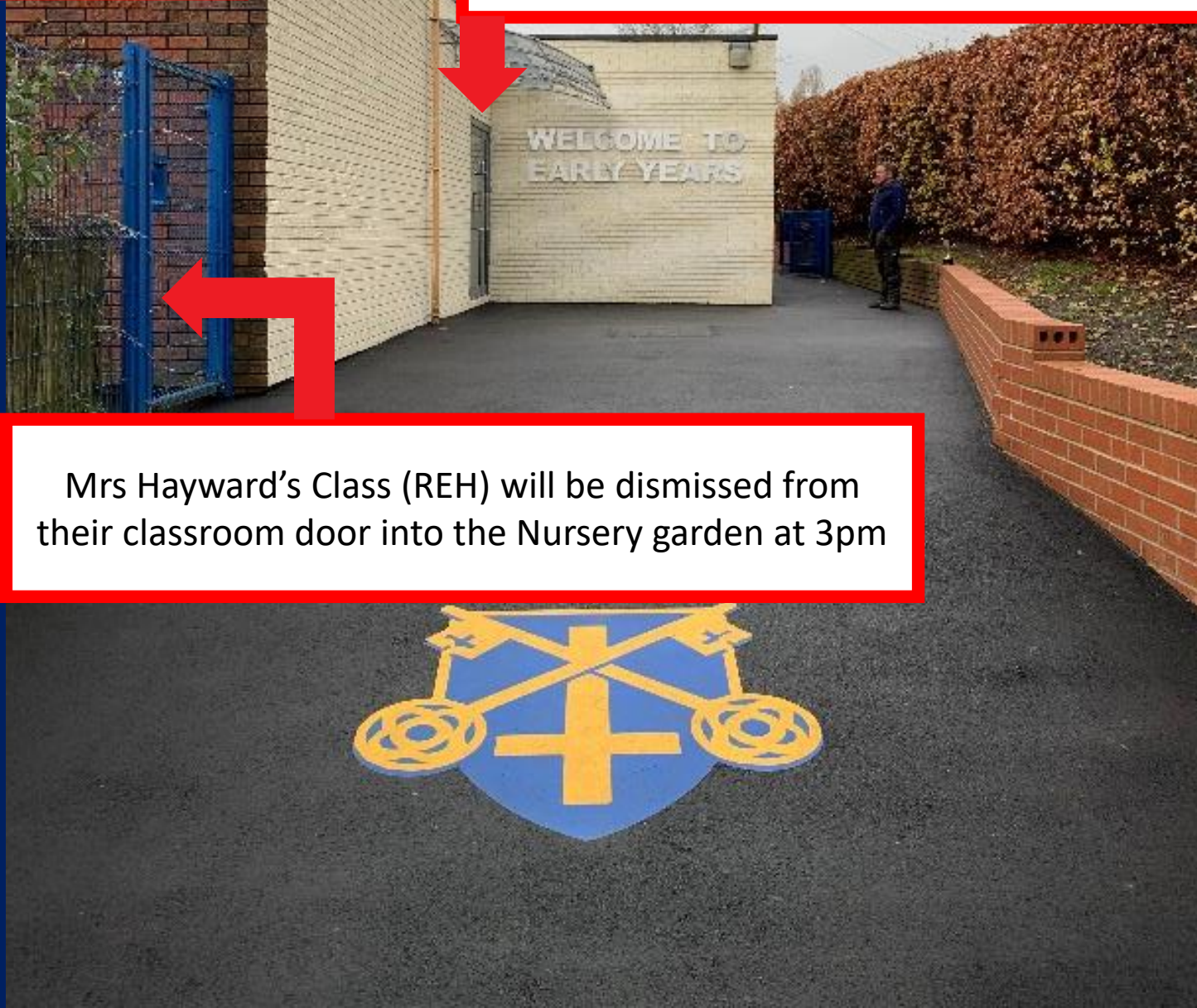
