Spellings are separated into weekly objectives; this allows you to follow the same sequence of learning at home as in school. Objectives that are in red are a $\mathrm{Y} 3 / \mathrm{Y} 4$ statutory requirement and individual words highlighted red are from the $\mathrm{Y} 3 / \mathrm{Y} 4$ statutory spelling list. The additional sets either: revise previously visited spelling rules from lower year groups; practise a spelling rule linked to a Y3/Y4 statutory spelling word or relate to a word, sentence or punctuation objective from the National Curriculum. Each set of spellings contains 10 words linked to the objective.
